Re: CRN Registration of Seamless Copper and Copper Alloy Tubing

This letter is to confirm that seamless copper and copper alloy tubing, in its original unpressurized form, does **not** require CRN Number Registration, under CSA codes B51 and B52.

Our product is considered to be a construction material. As such, it does not fall into any of the fittings categories listed in Table 1 of CSA B51 and is not subject to design registration requirements.

Once our customer incorporates the tubing into a pressure piping system or pressure vessel, their end product, if governed by code requirements, may require CRN number registration.

The above comments have been reviewed and confirmed by the Director of the Pressure Vessels Safety Branch of the Ontario Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations.
